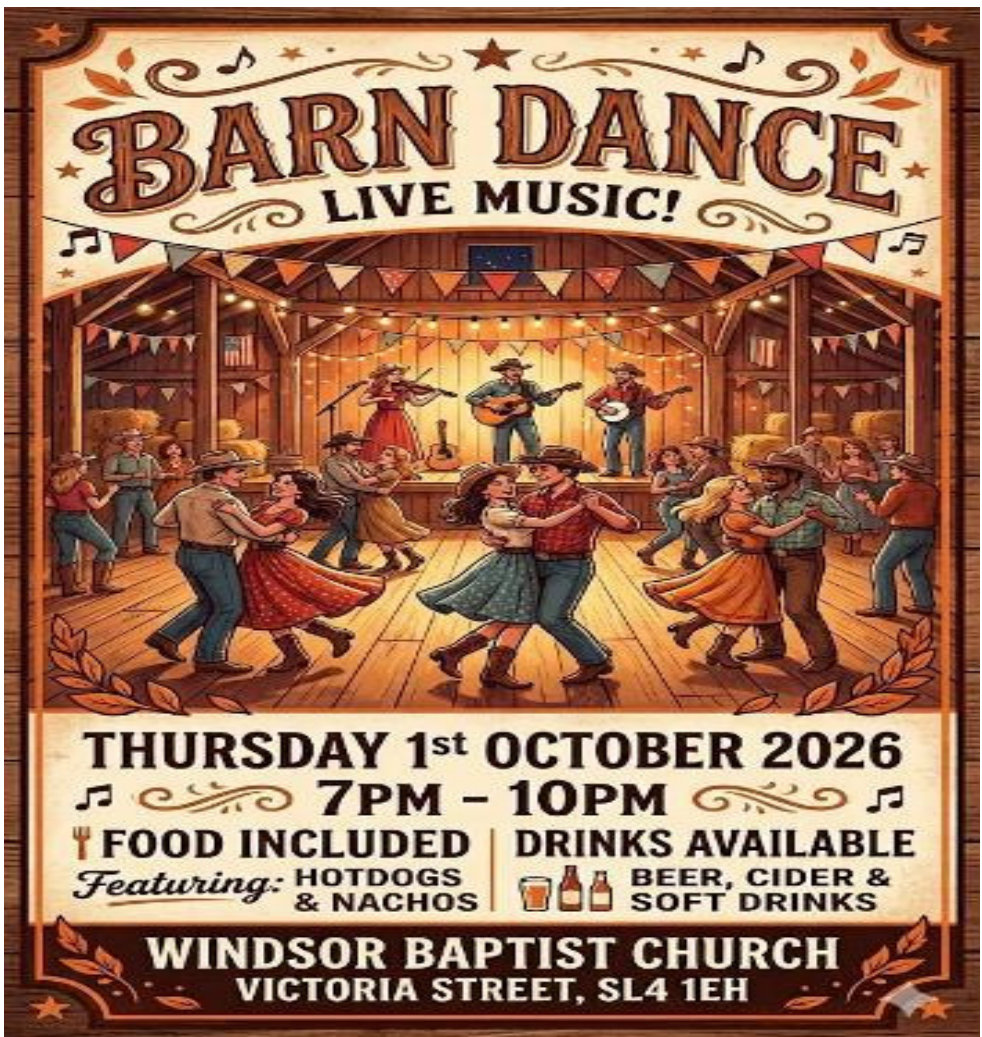
Please therefore, prayerfully consider what one-off gifts you might be able to make during October, using one of the methods listed below:
