Those moments stuck with me far more than I realised at the time. What really hit me recently was seeing you at BGS and watching my own students react to you in exactly the same way I once did. It was a real full-circle moment; standing at the back of the classroom as a teacher, but feeling like the kid who used to sit in class listening to you. It made me realise how rare it is for something from your childhood to still be impacting young people in the same way, twenty years later.***

***Having people like you come into schools genuinely matters; it stays with students long after the session ends. I know that because it stayed with me, and now I've seen it land with the next generation too.”***
