## **Families in Gaza need our help**

### **Could you help people like Noor?**

Noor went into labour with her youngest daughter with the sound of bombs falling all around her. Her husband, reliant on dialysis treatment, passed away in the hospital where they'd both been receiving care. She and her children, now bereaved, returned to empty cupboards. "We lived for five days without food or water, not even milk for my baby," she remembers.

On the third day, the house next to hers was bombed. Can you imagine the desperation Noor would have felt in the days and weeks that followed? There are countless families like Noor's in Gaza, struggling to get enough food, living in shelters or bomb-damaged homes and in need of urgent medical care.
